The mission of the Indiana Immunization Coalition (IIC) is to reduce the spread of vaccine-preventable diseases through immunization education, advocacy, promotion, and statewide collaborative partnerships.

WHO IS IIC?

In 2003 a team of Hoosiers, passionate about decreasing the spread of vaccine preventable disease in Indiana, formed the Indiana Immunization Coalition. IIC serves as an advocate for Indiana families, health care providers and local & state health departments striving to increase vaccination rates in Indiana.

HOW DOES IIC OPERATE?

IIC is a statewide 501(c)3 organization that is funded through grants and private donations. The board of directors, comprised of professionals from public and private organizations, oversees the work of IIC. IIC works closely with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the Indiana State Department of Health and other vaccination experts to provide the most accurate, comprehensive information available.

WHY ADVOCATE FOR VACCINES?

Vaccinations have significantly decreased the number of annual cases of vaccine-preventable diseases. Yet, people across Indiana are still getting sick, even dying, from these diseases every year. Through collaboration with public and private groups, IIC is on the front lines of reducing vaccine preventable diseases in Indiana.

FOCUS AREAS

EDUCATION

Educate stakeholders about emerging and best practices to ensure all people are vaccinated.

PROMOTION

Promote accurate information among the general public to eliminate myths, misconceptions, and fears of vaccinations and to raise awareness of their importance.

ADVOCACY

Advocate for policies and legislation related to immunization standards and best practices.

COLLABORATION

Engage a broad base of partners in advancing immunizations in Indiana.

HOW WE CAN HELP

Free materials

Educational lectures and seminars

IIC provides many opportunities each year for healthcare providers to continue their vaccine education. Meetings are held across the state at little or no charge to participants. Additionally, IIC can send a staff or board member to your facility to speak on a variety of topics. Past presentations have included:
