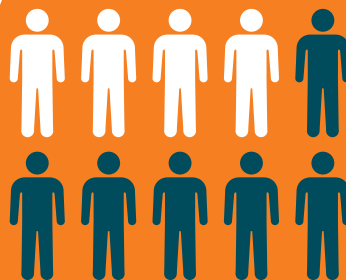

## WHAT IS HPV?

Human papillomavirus (HPV) is a common virus that can cause some types of cancers.

ONLY **4 OUT OF 10** TEENAGERS ARE FULLY VACCINATED BY AGE 18

Supporting **healthcare reminder systems** to improve vaccine series completion

Providing **vaccine catch-up through age 26** and discussing vaccination benefits with a healthcare provider from ages 27 – 45
