

Indiana Immunization Coalition Supports Federal Court Decision Protecting Science-Based Vaccine Guidance

The Indiana Immunization Coalition supports yesterday's federal court's decision to temporarily block recent changes to the nation's vaccine recommendation process and childhood immunization schedule.

For more than 50 years, U.S. vaccine recommendations have been guided by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP), an independent panel that evaluates vaccine safety and effectiveness through a transparent, science-based process.

Recent disruptions to this process have created uncertainty for families and health care providers. Preserving a consistent, evidence-driven system for vaccine guidance is essential to protecting public health.

This decision is an important step toward ensuring vaccine policy remains grounded in science and transparency. Protecting the integrity of the recommendation process helps protect Hoosier families.

The Indiana Immunization Coalition will continue to support evidence-based immunization practices that keep children and communities safe.
